

Dear Friends and Families,

We are very pleased to say that clinics are underway at all of our properties with an impressive rate of vaccination. I would also like to share with everyone the plan moving forward per the Illinois Department of Public Health. I am going to attempt to give a distilled version of what they have laid out.

- The state can change these plans at any time without notice.
- The state is encouraging us to utilize outdoors whenever possible.
- There are three phases of reopening and we must be in each phase for a minimum of 14 days before moving up to the next level.
- Moving through phases is contingent on the outside community at large and 14 days without a facility based positive and having ample protective equipment and staffing.
- We will continue to wear masks, practice social distancing and screen all people entering our community regardless of the phase.
- Phase 1-
  - Dining program will be as is
  - Activity program will be as is
  - Beauty shop will remain closed
  - Quarantine protocols will remain as they currently are
  - Testing will continue weekly and as needed
- Phase 2-
  - Dining will be unique to the communities' space
  - Group activities will be allowed up to 10 people, all wearing masks and social distancing.
  - Beauty shop will reopen with modifications if the beautician is agreeable.
  - Quarantine protocols will be as they currently are
  - Testing will continue weekly and as needed
  - Indoor visitation will be allowed in designated areas, by appointment only, with specific protocols in place including supervision as dictated by IDPH.
- Phase 3-
  - Dining will be unique to the communities' space.
  - Group activities will be modified to involve more people, all wearing masks and social distancing.
  - Beauty shop will remain open with modifications if the beautician is agreeable.
  - Quarantine protocols will be as they currently are
  - Testing will shift to monthly or as needed
  - Indoor visitation will be allowed in designated areas, by appointment only with specific protocols in place not including supervision.

I am hesitant in giving a time line because, as you know, the rules we are given change consistently and we cannot guarantee that we will not have individual positives at our communities. If the state changes the stage of reopening or if we have a community based positive then that building must return to phase 1. That said, the amount of people in our properties that have gotten the vaccine,

the amount of people in the community at large that have gotten the vaccine and the dramatic decrease in community cases and hospitalizations are very encouraging. Our next steps will all be research based as more and more data is coming in about the vaccines. I believe that we have turned a corner in our fight against this pandemic. Let us all continue to work together, follow all of the recommendations we have been given by the experts and keep each other safe.
